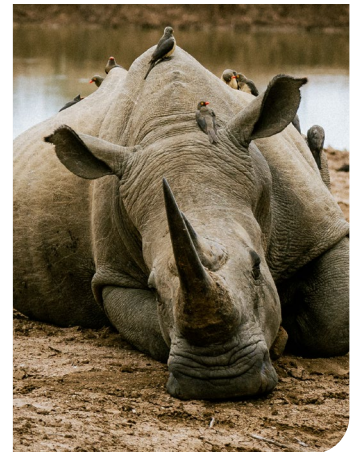

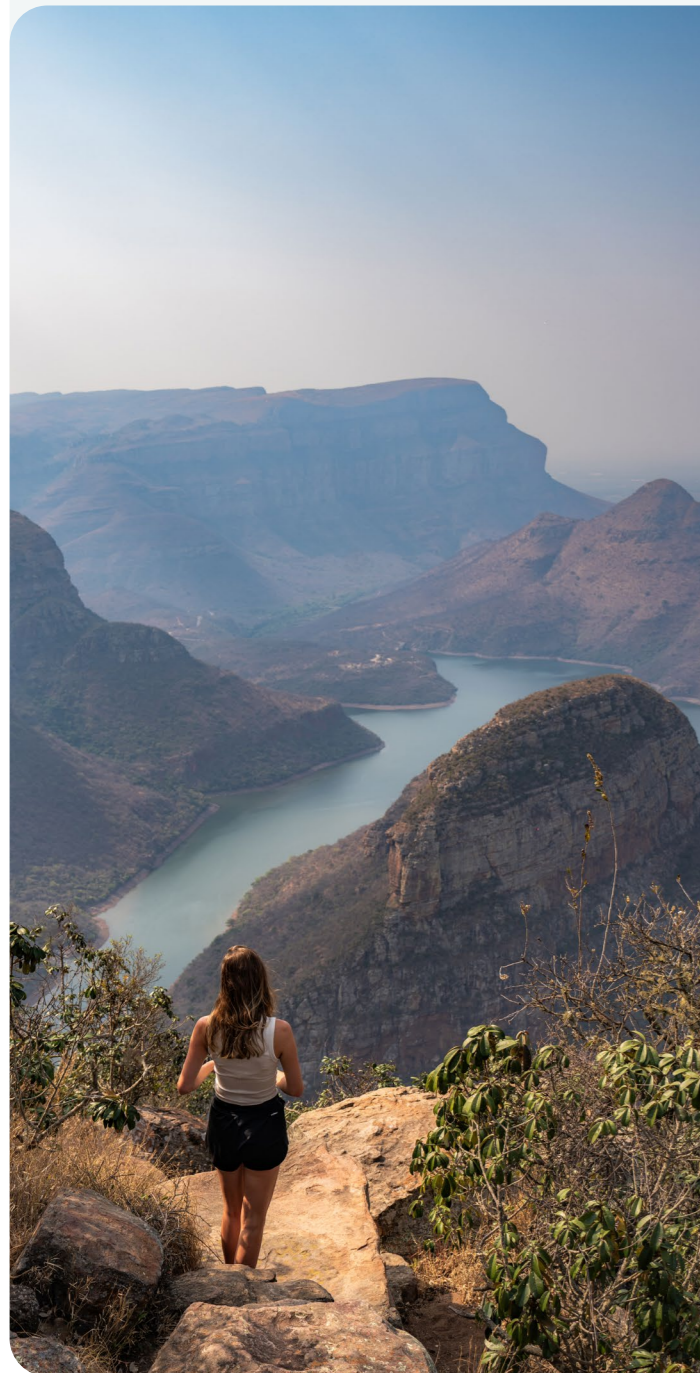

### Day 1: Arrive & Meet the Group

 Johannesburg  
Welcome to South Africa! Once you arrive in Johannesburg we'll take you to our hotel. You'll have plenty of time to recover from your flight before meeting everyone in your group.


### Day 2: Explore Johannesburg

 Johannesburg  
First up today we're learning about the history of Soweto township. We'll visit the beautifully designed Apartheid Museum or Mandela's House depending on availability. Later we'll head out for some drinks at the best watering holes around.


### Day 3: The Panorama Route

 Graskop  
Today we leave JoBurg to head into the depths of Africa. We'll have breakfast at the hotel, then drive the renowned Panorama Route to see some of Africa's most stunning landscapes.


### Day 4: Kruger National Park

 Kruger National Park  
We're off to Kruger National Park, crossing our fingers for our first sightings of exotic wildlife on our drive. Tonight our guide will give us an explanation of the history of our dinner, known as braai; a traditional South African BBQ before we spend the night gazing up at an infinite, starry sky.


### Day 5: Open Vehicle Game Drive

 Kruger National Park  
Today is a trip highlight - a once in a lifetime open vehicle game drive through Kruger National Park! We'll look out for herds of mighty elephants, rhinos, buffalos, prides of lions and lurking leopards, and our experienced guides will ensure we have the best possible experience. Tonight at our pre-erected campsite we enjoy a traditional Potjie, a South African dish that is traditionally cooked outdoors in a cast iron cauldron.


### Day 6: Travel to Eswatini

 Hlane Royal National Park  
This morning we'll cross the border to Eswatini, a small landlocked nation that hosts Hlane Royal National Park. This evening is another chance to spot your favourite animals on a sunset game drive through the grasslands. Tonight if we are lucky, we'll be treated to a show from rangers performing their traditional style of Swazi singing.


### Day 7: Local Way of Life

 Zululand  
Today we journey back into South Africa, traveling south towards Mkuzie. After we arrive, we'll stop by a local crèche to connect with the community and spend some time with the children, getting a glimpse into their daily school life. Later this afternoon, we'll have the opportunity to relax and make the most of our beautiful accom before dinner.

### Day 8: Coastal Towns


 Blythedale  
This morning, we'll spend time in a local Zulu village, discovering what traditional life is like in the rural countryside. Afterwards, we'll make our way to the coast and settle into our beach lodge. The afternoon is yours to unwind - whether that's lounging on the sand or taking a dip in the pool. Tonight, we'll dig into a local favourite: Bunny Chow, a beloved South African dish made from a loaf of bread packed with curry - definitely a must-try!

### Day 9: Table Mountain


 Cape Town  
We're off early this morning to catch our short flight to Cape Town. This afternoon we rise to the heavens as we summit the iconic Table Mountain (weather permitting, alternative activity in winter). Crisp air accompanies dramatic views, earning Table Mountain its title as one of the New 7 Wonders of Nature, and we'll soak up a stunning scenes over the majestic natural amphitheatre. This evening we'll make our way to the V&A Waterfront to stroll, shop, and take in the views.

### Day 10: Explore Cape Town

 Cape Town  
Today we head off on a walking tour of Bo-Kaap, an area known for its colourful houses and Cape Malay culture. The tour will continue with a drive past the Houses of Parliament, the City Hall, Slave Lodge, District 6 Museum, Slave Lodge, The Castle, and Cape Town Stadium. We'll finish the day with a cocktail in hand as we watch the sun set.

### Day 11: Cape Peninsula

 Cape Town  
Gear up for a day of adventure as we explore the dramatic beaches and cliffs of Cape Peninsula. We'll go on a cruise to get up close and personal with wild fur seals, stop for photos at the impressive Chapman's Peak, then hang out with a colony of wild African Penguins on Boulders Beach. Tonight we're out for our farewell dinner at a funky restaurant.

### Day 12: Check Out & Onward Travel

Your amazing 12 day adventure comes to an end. You can either check out and make your way back home, extend your stay in Cape Town, or continue your travels in Africa. We'll be on hand to help you with any onward travel!

# Morocco Adventure

- Visit three unforgettable cities; the blue-washed streets of Chefchaouen, the rich, authentic feel of Fes' old medina and the vibrant, fast-paced energy of Marrakech
- Spend a night under the stars in the Sahara Desert, with sandboarding, a 4x4 dune adventure, camel rides and some of the most unforgettable sunrises and sunsets you'll ever see
- Get a true taste of Moroccan hospitality as you explore traditional Berber villages, share tea with a local family and join in hands-on cooking demonstrations and classes

## Itinerary

### Day 1: Arrive in Casablanca

Casablanca

Your adventure begins in Morocco's largest city, right on the coast. We'll pick you up from the airport and take you to your hotel, where you can meet your group, grab a bite, and start getting excited. The real fun starts tomorrow!

### Day 2: Mosques & Chefchaouen

Chefchaouen

We start the day at the Hassan II Mosque in Casablanca - an enormous and striking landmark. Then we head to Rabat to explore the Hassan Tower and the Mausoleum of Mohammed V, marvels of Arab-Andalusian architecture. Later, we'll arrive in Chefchaouen. Settle in over dinner and get ready - tomorrow promises an unforgettable day.

### Day 3: The Blue City & Waterfalls

Chefchaouen

In Chefchaouen, we'll roam the twisting blue streets and hidden alleyways, discovering the town's charm around every corner. Then it's off to the Akchour Waterfalls, where you can plunge into the cool mountain waters and let the scenery take your breath away.

### Day 4: Roman Ruins & Fes

Fes

We leave the Blue City behind and make our way to Fes, stopping at Volubilis along the way. Wander among its well-preserved Roman ruins, with ancient columns, mosaics, and history around every corner. In the afternoon, we'll reach Fes - a city that's stayed true to itself, full of local character and the authentic feel of Morocco.

### Day 5: Local Medinas & Hands-On Crafts

Fes

We kick off the day with a walking tour through the heart of Fes Medina, where every street bursts with colour, noise, and the scent of spices - it feels like stepping back in time. After soaking it all in, it's your turn to get creative: try your hand at pottery and zellige mosaic-making, two of Fes' most iconic crafts.

### Day 6: Traditional Berber Village & Tea

Midelt

As we begin the long drive to the Sahara, we'll stop in Midelt and visit a traditional Berber village tucked in the foothills of the Atlas Mountains. Here, a local family will welcome you with mint tea and Moroccan treats, giving you a taste of everyday life in the region.  
*Small Change: Have tea with a Berber family in their village for a genuine cultural exchange that supports rural communities and keeps local traditions alive.*

### Day 7: Sahara Desert Camp

Sahara Desert Camp

Today we make our way to the heart of the Sahara. Along the way, we'll visit another local family for lunch and a hands-on cooking demonstration of traditional Moroccan dishes. Then comes the highlight: a night under the desert sky. We'll ride in 4x4s over the dunes to reach our camp, where you can explore on foot or hop on a camel, try sandboarding, and watch the sunset transform the desert around you.

*Small Change: Our camels are handled by local Berber families who have cared for these animals for generations - rested, well-fed, and treated as the working companions they are.*

### Day 8: Dunes to Pool

Merzouga

Take a breather today and enjoy the desert at a slower pace. Start with a sunrise stroll through the dunes, then hop in a 4x4 for a short drive back to Merzouga. Our hotel is right on the desert's edge, so you're already there. The rest of the day is yours - swim, sunbathe, or just kick back and do nothing.

### Day 9: Todra Gorge & Ouarzazate

Ouarzazate

It's time to trade desert sands for mountain scenery. We'll start by visiting the underground water tunnels of Ouattou Khetaras, then take a walk through Todra Gorge, where massive rock walls rise on either side. Tonight we settle in Ouarzazate, ready for the next day's journey further into the mountains.

### Day 10: Movie Sets & Mountain Peaks

Imlil

Today, we head to Ait Benhaddou, a legendary site that's been featured in Gladiator, Game of Thrones, and numerous other films. After a stroll through its historic streets, the journey continues to the mountain town of Imlil, nestled among dramatic peaks and valleys, with Mount Toubkal, North Africa's tallest mountain, dominating the skyline.

### Day 11: Mountain Hike & Cooking Class

Marrakech

Spend the morning in the Atlas Mountains - trek through the dramatic, snow-capped peaks or simply relax on your hotel balcony and take in the views. In the afternoon, we head to Marrakech for a hands-on cooking class, where you'll learn to make classic Moroccan dishes from scratch.

*Small Change: Cook alongside Chef Laila in her family home, where your visit directly supports a local family-run business at the heart of the Marrakech community.*

### Day 12: Marrakech Medina

Marrakech

Today is all about the energy of Marrakech. We'll explore the medina on foot, weaving through bustling souks, tasting local street food, and soaking up the sights and sounds of Jemaa el-Fna. In the evening, we'll gather for our final group dinner, raising a toast to 13 unforgettable days of adventure.

### Day 13: Check Out & Onward Travel

Marrakech

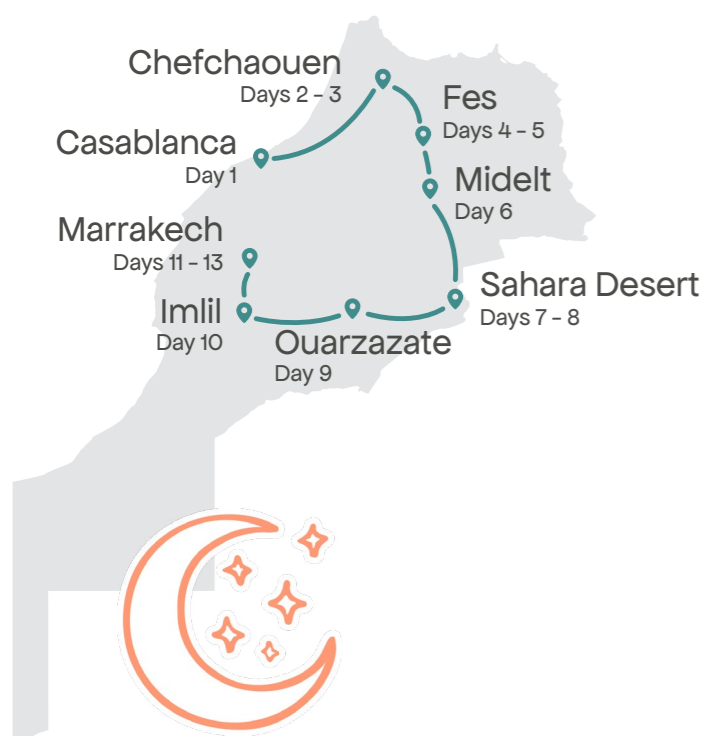

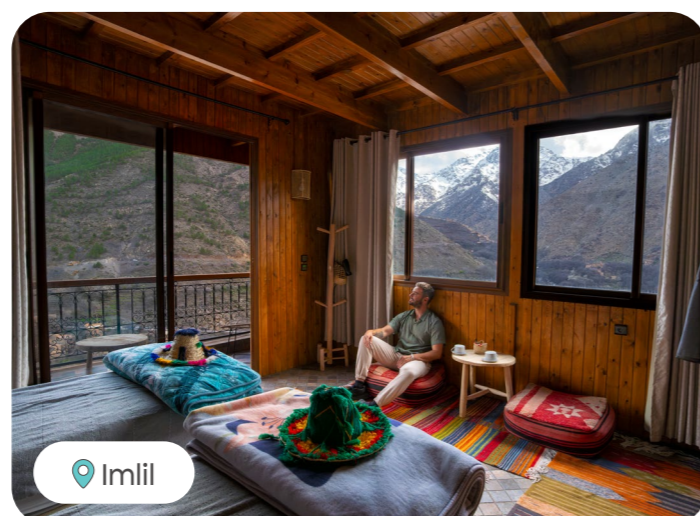
